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SECTION I. NOTICE INVITING TENDER

1. Bank Note Paper Mill India Private Limited (BNPM) is a joint venture company between Bharatiya Reserve Bank Note Mudran Private Limited (A wholly owned subsidiary of Reserve Bank of India) and Security Printing and Minting Corporation of India Limited (100% owned by Government of India), incorporated for setting up & manufacturing of bank note papers at Mysore. e bids are invited by BNPM from eligible & financially sound bidders for Sale of General Waste at BNPM, Mysore - 570003.
2. e-Bids may submitted in online mode for Sale of General Waste (Scrap) at BNPM, Mysore - 570003 by eligible & financially sound bidders.

Online mode of bid submission (e tender):

 - b. Aspiring Bidders/Contractors who have not registered in e-tendering should register through the website E - Tendering (www.tenderwizard.com/BNP) for participating in the Online Tenders. **The registration charges will be Rs. 3,000/- plus applicable taxes (per year) which needs to be paid through electronic mode only. Tender processing fee is Rs. 3,000/- plus applicable Taxes.**

 - d. The NIT along with tender documents will be accessible in the e-Tendering website (viz www.tenderwizard.com/BNP).
 - e. Class III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) is mandatory to participate in e-Tenders. Participating bidders/Contractors have to make sure that they have the valid DSC. If not, they can procure from any of the RAs approved by CCA.
 - f. Bidders/Contractors should upload and attach all the Scanned copies of technical documents/certificates in e-tendering website www.tenderwizard.com/BNP pertaining to their eligibility criteria mentioned in the NIT, failing which, the bid will not be considered.
3. **Eligibility Criteria:** The prospective bidders should submit the documents as mentioned below.
 - a. Proof of registration i.e., valid GST and PAN.
 - b. For the quoted item/schedule, the bidder shall have

- i. KSPCB/ CPCB/respective SPCB (in case of sale involving transboundary movement) authorization for applicable Basel nos for handling the respective wastes under Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, issued by gazetted notification vide MOEFCC, GOI on dated 04.04.2016.
- ii. Aforementioned authorization from KSPCB/ CPCB/respective SPCB (in case of sale involving transboundary movement) should be valid and in force on the date of opening of the tender.

Note: Annexures issued against consent are not applicable to comply eligibility criteria against respective item/schedule.

It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to substantiate the eligibility criteria with documentary evidence.

c. General Criteria : Bidder to submit following declaration:

- i. Bidder shall submit a declaration that they will re-cycle / re-process the scarp as per the rules prescribed in Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) rule.
- ii. Other waste (scrap) shall be collected from BNPM premises as per the KSPCB/CPCB regulations.
- iii. Loading, transportation, unloading, reprocessing shall be done by the bidder as per hazardous & other waste (Management & transboundary movement) Rule 2016. Any deviations during the process shall be solely attributed to the bidder. Bidder required to abide to the guidelines prescribed by the KSPCB/CPCB.
- iv. Bidder, without failing, shall obtain **Form 9 (Transport Emergency Card/TREM)** duly filled from the BNPM before the hazardous waste leaving the premises of BNPM.
- v. The transportation of the hazardous waste shall be in accordance with the existing rules and guidelines by the respective pollution control board and in accordance with the rules made by central Govt under motor vehicles act 1984. The transportation vehicle shall have along with it, the **Fitness certificate of the vehicle**, valid documents/authorization from KSPCB/CPCB for the transportation of the Hazardous waste.
- vi. The safe transport of the hazardous waste shall be sole responsibility of the receiver and shall have the necessary authorization for the transportation by the concerned state pollution control board. The same shall be clearly indicated in the manifest (**Form -10**).
- vii. On receipt of the material, **Form 10** - Hazardous Waste Manifest for disposal shall be sole responsible of the receiver and shall have the necessary authorization shall be issued to BNPMIPL. It will be the sole responsibility of bidder to use the material as per KSPCB/CPCB norms.
- viii. In case of transportation of hazardous waste for final disposal to a facility existing in a State other than the State where the waste is generated, the sender shall obtain '**No Objection Certificate**' from the **State Pollution Control Board of both the States** with whom the buyer is registered, failing which buyer will be responsible for the consequences and BNPM shall take further action as deemed fit.

- ix. Bidder shall maintain records of hazardous waste purchased in a passbook issued by the State Pollution Control Board along with the authorization.
 - x. Hazardous waste shall be handed over to the **bidder only after making the entry into the passbook** Issued by KSPCB/CPCB.
4. Online bids are to be submitted through e tender portal (www.tenderwizard.com/BNP) only.

Note:

Against receipt of the following notification through email from tenderwizard portal, bidder must resubmit the bid even if the bidder have already submitted the bid through tenderwizard portal.

Notification: If you have already submitted the tender, then ensure that you resubmit the tender. Else, your bid may be liable to be auto disqualified by the system. And service provider holds no responsibility for the same. In case, you are yet to submit the tender, then please ensure that you submit it before the tender closing time.

Submission / resubmission of the bid is the responsibility of the bidders only. Bidder should check and confirm at their end regarding the submission/ resubmission of their bid till the due date & time of bid submission. BNPM / Keonics/ Tenderwizard will not be responsible for non-submission/ non resubmission of any bid.

4. Bid submission procedure:

Online bids:

Tenders are to be uploaded on e-tendering portal www.tenderwizard.com/BNP only in Two part bid system.

i) Part-I - Prequalification Bid & Techno-commercial Bid: Registration Fee, Tender Processing Fee, EMD/Bid Security Declaration as per Annexure A is to be submitted (For MSE Bidder) ,Scanned copy of supporting documents related to eligibility criteria (As mentioned in NIT) along with all sections , annexures of this tender (except Sec – IV, Price Schedule , which has to be submitted as mentioned in Sl.No.ii below) duly signed & stamped by authorised person in each & every page. (To be submitted through E-portal only)

ii) Part II – Price Bid: Price Bid shall be submitted through e-portal only, the price bid is liable for rejection if submitted in any other mode. Price Bid should be submitted as per the price bid format provided in Sec –IV, Price Schedule of this tender. **Price Bid submitted in any other format will be liable for rejection. Price bids with conditions / Counter conditions are liable for rejection.**

6. Tenders not properly filled, mutilated with incorrect calculations or generally not complying with the conditions may be rejected. In line with evaluation criteria bid may be submitted item/schedule wise.
7. **Bid Validity:** The tender shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of the tender.
8. **EVALUATION CRITERIA:**
 - 8.1 At first stage, techno-commercial bid will be opened and evaluated by the competent committee / authority with reference to the parameters prescribed in the tender document. Subsequently in the second stage the financial bids of only techno commercially acceptable offer as decided in first stage shall be opened for further scrutiny and evaluation. Intimation regarding opening of financial bids shall be given to acceptable tenderers to enable them to attend the financial bid opening, if they so desire.
 - 8.2 **The method of evaluation of price bid for awarding the sale order shall be on schedule/item wise H1 basis against effective price (i.e without GST) only. If the schedule wise H1 prices are same for different bidders then the order will be placed on proportionate quantity basis.**
 - 8.3 However, the acceptance of the tender will rest with BNPM, who does not bind himself to accept the highest tender and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.
 - 8.4 BNPM also reserves the right to allot the order partly or wholly to single or different Tenderer. BNPM reserves the right to reject any offer including the highest one if the same is not conforming to its norms. The decision of BNPM in this regard will be final.
 - 8.5 If there is any tie between the quoted H1 rates of the bidders for an item/schedule then the awards will be on proportionate quantity basis.
9. **Discrepancy in Prices:**
 - 9.1 If, in the price structure quoted by a tenderer, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless BNPM feels that the tenderer has made a mistake in placing the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall prevail over the unit price and the unit price corrected accordingly.

- 9.2 If, there is an error in a total price, which has been worked out through addition and/ or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total corrected; and
- 9.3 If, there is a discrepancy between the amount expressed in words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.
- 9.4 If, as per the judgment of BNPM, there is any such arithmetical discrepancy in a tender, the same will be suitably conveyed to the tenderer by registered/speed post/email. If the tenderer does not agree to the observation of BNPM, the tender is liable to be ignored.

10. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):** Interest free EMD of Rs 3,32,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Thirty Two Thousand only). The EMD shall be paid through online at e-tender portal (www.tenderwizard.com/BNP). The tender without EMD shall be liable for rejection. Submission of EMD is exempted for Micro and small enterprises (MSEs) as per the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order, 2012. MSEs should be registered and also will continue to remain registered during the tender validity period with District Industries Centre (DIC) or Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) or Khadi and Industries Board (KVIB) or Coir Board or National Small Industries Commission (NSIC) or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handlooms or UDYAM or Any other body specified by Ministry of MSME. For EMD waiver, valid NSIC/UDYAM/any other doc as applicable is to be submitted along with Annexure A (Bid Security Declaration). For successful bidders interest free EMD amount will be released on submission of security deposit amount, if security deposit is submitted in form BG then EMD will be released after confirmation of BG from respective Bank. For unsuccessful bidders interest free EMD shall be released after finalization of the sale order.

EMD may be furnished in the form of:

- i. Account payee demand draft
 - ii. Unconditional Bank Guarantee issued and confirmed from any scheduled commercial bank in India with validity up to 60(sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations including warranty period.
 - iii. Fixed deposit receipt (FDR) from a scheduled commercial bank in India, lien marked to Bank Note Paper Mill India Pvt Ltd, Mysore
 - iv. Online payment in an acceptable form.
 - v. Insurance surety bond
11. **Performance Security/Security Deposit (SD):** Within ten (10) days after the issue of notification of award (i.e sale order) by BNPM, the successful bidder shall furnish performance security to BNPM for an amount equal to ten (10) per cent (%) of the total value of the contract.

Performance security may be furnished in the form of:

- i. Account payee demand draft

- ii. Unconditional Bank Guarantee issued and confirmed from any scheduled commercial bank in India with validity up to 60(sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations including warranty period.
- iii. Fixed deposit receipt (FDR) from a scheduled commercial bank in India, lien marked to Bank Note Paper Mill India Pvt Ltd, Mysore
- iv. Online payment in an acceptable form.
- v. Banker's cheque

If the successful bidder fails to resume/complete the work within stipulated time, security deposit of such bidder shall be forfeited. SD shall be interest free. **If the successful bidder fails to submit the Security Deposit & does not lift the scrap material within 2 months of order placement, then BNPM has the right to cancel the order & debar/blacklist that bidder.**

12. **Terms of Sale:** Successful Bidder has to submit advance amount which is equivalent to the value of the scrap to be lifted preferably 3 days before lifting the material.

The advance payment should be made vide electronic transfer/ Deposit to the Bank Account of Bank Note Paper Mill India Pvt Ltd.

Successful Bidder shall be allowed to lift the material only if the advance amount is equivalent to the scrap to be lifted.

13. **Site Visit/ Inspection:** To assess the state/ conditions of scrap to determine the price to be quoted, the Bidder is advised to visit the project site before bid submission due date and time to get acquainted with the conditions at the site.

For visiting BNPM, Mysore plant prior permission is to be taken by prospective bidders from competent authority at BNPM, Mysore. Email may be send at scm.tender@bnpmindia.com in this regard.

14. **Completion Time, free delivery time, ground rent:** Work for lifting the available scarp materials shall be started within 10 working days of issue of Sale Order and lifting of the available scrap should be finished within 45 days (free delivery period) from the date of issue of Sale Order. The scrap materials available thereafter shall be lifted as and when available and as per the schedule provided by BNPM for disposal up to a period of One Year from the date of issuance of order with same ordered price and terms & conditions. The delivery of material will be given only against advance payment. If the successful bidder (purchaser) is not able to lift the material within the free delivery period i.e 45 days (initial), then the purchaser may request for an extension. Such extensions may be granted after levying a ground rent at ½ % (half percent) of the sale value per day. Subsequently, against each schedule as provided by BNPM any delay beyond 15 days in lifting the scrap items may attract a ground rent at ½ % (half percent) of the sale value per week maximum upto 10% of the sale value. However, the

levy of ground rent may be waived as per the discretion of BNPM and considering the genuinely of the case.

15. Tenders for Sale of General Waste:

The tender is for Sale of General Waste. Details of scrap for sale including Description, Lot Size would be given in the "List of General Waste".

- a.** "As -Is- Where- Is" Basis of This Sale:
- b.** This sale of Scrap is strictly on " As -Is- Where- Is " basis. Tenderer must satisfy himself on all matters with regard to quality, quantity; nature of stores etc., before tendering as no complaint or representation of any kind shall be entertained after the sale contract is concluded.
- c.** The description of lot in the particulars of sale (If any) has been given for the purpose of identification thereof only and the use of such description shall not constitute the sale thereof to be sale by description and no sale shall be invalid by reason of any defect or deviation or variation in any lot or on account of any lot not being exactly described and the purchaser shall not be entitled to claim any damage or compensation whatsoever on account of such fault, error in description, weight or the like.
- d.** All quantities of scrap whether by weight or measurement mentioned in the Tender notice are only approximate and should the quantity , on actual weight or measurement basis as the case may be and whenever delivered on such basis, works out less than the advertised and /or projected quantity, the BNPM shall not under any circumstances be liable to make good any such deficiency
- e.** BNPM reserves right to increase or decrease the quantity of any item or items or terminate the contract at any stage by giving one week's notice. No claim whatsoever shall lie against the BNPM on account of such termination of the contract or variation in the quantity.
- f.** BNPM shall have the right to remove certain items which it feels were not intended for sale but were inadvertently made a part of the scrap material or of the lot offered for sale lying at the premises or were joined or attached to the material offered for sale.
- g.** Tenderers desirous of purchasing and participating in the tender may visit the site before submitting the offer, after taking due permission from the concerned Stock Holders. The Tenderers submitting the offers shall be deemed to have visited the site and acquainted themselves thoroughly with materials intended for sale in all respect.
- h.** Any person giving offer shall be deemed to have made himself fully conversant with the Terms and Conditions of the Tender Sale, as well as the location and condition of the materials being sold and shall be deemed to have agreed to all the stated terms and conditions herein under.

16. Disposal Tenders for Security and Sensitive Machinery and Items: Not applicable.

17. **Non-Misuse Declaration:**

The bidder is required to give an undertaking that he or his employees or legal heirs will ensure that such items purchased from BNPM, will be utilized only for scrap recovery and will not be misused for any other purpose. He will also ensure that this undertaking is honored and it got underwritten from further down the line scrap processors/ re-purchasers, if any. In case his firm changes hands, it will be his responsibility to ensure that the new owners honor and underwrite this undertaking.

18. **Procedure for Disposal of General Waste:**

On finalization of tender, a sale order will be issued to successful bidder by BNPM for the existing available quantity, which has to be completed lifting within 45 days from the date of issue of sale order. The contractor shall make advance payment as mentioned above for the material to be lifted.

Scraps are to be lifted "As Is; Where Is; Whatever Is" basis. No picking, choosing, sorting, welding, cutting or breaking of Goods or materials sold will be permitted unless otherwise specified. In used/waste oil, separation of oil and water, and so on, shall not be allowed at the site. If these actions are allowed. If any foreign materials are found to be mixed in the lot, other than the items included in the sale order, the seller reserves the right to remove them at the time of delivery. The buyer shall not be entitled to re-sell an item, lot or part of a lot while the Goods are still lying within the premises of the seller and any such sale or assignment of the buyer's right to the material sold will not be recognized. All documents for releasing materials will be made out in the name of the buyer only.

Bidder shall arrange vehicle, if any, Tools & tackles /materials required & labour for collection from various places in the site, loading, transportation at their own cost. The safety of the labour will be the responsibility of the bidder. The operation is to be completed within the specified office hours i.e. between 1000 hrs and 1600 hrs. No work shall be permitted on Sundays or on closed holidays.

Bidder shall not be allowed to pick and choose the materials. Hazardous waste has to be lifted as per the instruction of BNPM only. These material should not be sold to the employees of BNPM. Undertaking this regard has to be provided. The scrap material will be delivered only to the successful bidder or their authorized representatives against the presentation of the buyer's identity proof. If the successful bidder desires to authorize a representative or an agent to accept delivery, the bidder shall produce a suitable power of attorney or authorization letter for each lot separately, duly attested, by a notary public authorizing their representative or agent to lift the material from the seller.

Note: Instruction for disposal of paper briquettes:

- a. For filling paper briquettes, successful bidders to provide good quality empty bags (holding capacity of approximately 30 Kg) as & when informed by BNPM,Mysore.
- b. The successful bidder to deploy vehicle when the accumulated paper briquette quantity reaches approximately 10 MT or as & when informed by BNPM without any counter terms & conditions.

19. Non-performance of the successful bidder:

Successful bidder should adhere the schedule of lifting of the scrap as provided by BNPM time to time. During the execution of the contract if the performance of the bidder is found unsatisfactory then BNPM has the right to (i) Terminate the contract (ii) Forfeit the security deposit amount (iii) Debar/ Blacklist the bidder.

20. Compliance of security Norms:

BNPM is a security organization located in the premises of BRBNMPL and the Govt. of Karnataka declares the premises as Prohibited Area. Hence the contractor has to abide by the security rules of the Company. The contractor has to ensure the character and antecedent of the persons deployed. The contractor must be in a position to produce such documents whenever he is asked to do so. Details shall be furnished as per format when called for. The contractor has to issue printed photo identity card to its workers duly authenticated by the designated security officer of the Company. Contractor should apply for Gate Pass for labours, welding permission and material entry pass etc. as per approved format only, well in advance to avoid any delay in issue of Gate passes.

21. Performance in executing previous contracts:

Performance of the bidders in executing the previous orders will be considered for techno commercial evaluation. Any non-performance in executing the previous contracts may lead to techno commercial disqualification as per the discretion of BNPM,Mysore.

22. Default be buyer: Materials sold but not removed within the specified date will become the property of the seller and it will have the right to dispose of such Goods in any manner as he deems fit without any notice.

23. BNPM reserves right to increase or decrease the quantity of any item or items or terminate the contract at any stage by giving one week's notice. No claim whatsoever shall lie against the BNPM on account of such termination of the contract or variation in the quantity. BNPM shall have the right to remove certain items which it feels were not intended for sale but were inadvertently made a part of the scrap material or of the lot offered for sale lying at the premises or were joined or attached to the material offered for sale. Tenderers desirous of purchasing and participating in the tender must visit the site before submitting the offer, after taking due permission from the concerned Stock

Holders. The Tenderers submitting the offers shall be deemed to have visited the site and acquainted themselves thoroughly with materials intended for sale in all respect. Any person giving offer shall be deemed to have made himself fully conversant with the Terms and Conditions of the Tender Sale, as well as the location and condition of the materials being sold and shall be deemed to have agreed to all the stated terms and conditions herein under.

24. **Contract period:** Sale order shall remain valid for one year from the date of issuance of sale order. BNPM reserves the right to extend the contract period of the sale order as suitable in case of available open quantity against ordered scrap items and may short close the extended contract period with 15 days' notice.

25. **Conflict of interest:**

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practice to the detriment of BNPM interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified after giving a reasonable opportunity of being heard. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a. they have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b. they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/financial stake from any of them; or
- c. they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid;
- d. they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder; or
- e. Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a bidder in more than one bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/sub-assembly/assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid.
- f. In cases of agent's quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorize only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:
 - i. The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
 - ii. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal.
- g. A Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or TS of the contract that is the subject of the bid;
- h. In case of a holding company having more than one independently

manufacturing units, or more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit should quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies. Bidders must proactively declare such sister/ common business/ management units in same/ similar line of business.

In the event of the bidder having any conflict of interest, such bidder is obligated to disclose the same to BNPM. Failure to do so will disqualify the bidder.

26. Obligations by bidders:

- a. All bidders are obliged under the CIPP to suo-moto proactively declare any conflict of interest (coming under the definition mentioned above (point no 25) – pre-existing or as and as soon as these arise at any stage) in any procurement process or execution of contract. Failure to do so would amount to violation of this Code of Integrity; and
- b. Any bidder must declare, whether asked or not in a bid document, any previous transgressions of such a Code of Integrity with any entity in any country during the last 3 (Three) years or of being debarred by any other Procuring Entity. Failure to do so would amount to violation of this code of integrity.
