1. Documents to be submitted:

- a) Signed copy of this document (All the pages).
- b) Eligibility Criteria: The bidder should be accredited with INS (Indian Newspaper Society).
- c) Filled price details as per the format provided below in this document.
- d) Technical details /datasheet for the enquired product (if applicable).

2. Score of work:

2.1 Publishing recruitment advertisement in Times of India (Karnataka edition) on unit rate contract basis for period of 03 months.

2.2 BNPM will provide the "Text Matter" (Recruitment Advertisements) in English Language to be published in different newspapers on case to case basis and the advertising work shall be carried out by the Service Provider upon receipt of approval as per given matter/approved art work in the specified newspaper(s) within the time schedule.

2.3 Art Work:

The successful bidder / agency shall translate the "Text Matter" (Advertisements) in ENGLISH language to be published in different newspaper on case to case basis as intimated by BNPM.

2.4 The successful bidder has to publish the approved artwork in newspaper in India as advised by BNPM within the stipulated time frame.

2.5 The successful bidder has to submit the bills, along with the necessary paper cuttings of the published material. If published from more than one Centre/editions, paper cuttings of all the centers/ editions have to be submitted.

2.6 BNPM reserves the right to publishing advertisements in any newspapers or combination of newspapers as specified above as per company advertisement policy.

3. SCHEDULE TIME OF ADVERTISEMENT: Successful bidder should be publishing advertisements in newspaper(s) as specified by BNPM within 2 days from the date of receipt of Work Order.

4. PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

The rate contract shall be entered with the successful bidder for a period of three (03) months from the date of LOI. However, the contract can be terminated at any point of time at the discretion of BNPMIPL if performance found unsatisfactory.

5. Price: Price should be inclusive of GST. Price shall remain fixed & no price variation shall be accepted till completion of contract.



6. Terms of Payment: 100% within 30 days from the date of completion of work and on submission of all relevant documents.

Payment shall be done in INR only by the supplier. NEFT/RTGS details shall be furnished along with the Original Invoice.

7. Evaluation Criteria:

- i. The method of evaluation of price bid for awarding the contract shall be schedule wise L1 basis only.
- ii. If tie happens among one or two agency, then the BNPM existing advertising agency will be considered as the winning bidder. If tie among other agency (other than the existing agency) the bidder with the maximum average turnover in last three financial year (FY:2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22) shall be declared as winning bidder.

8. Liquidated Damages (LD):

Liquidated damages shall be applicable at the rate of 0.5% per week or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of 10% of the delayed good's /service's contract price.

9. Delay in supplier's performance:

Time for and the date specified in the contract or as extended for the delivery of the stores shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the supplier shall deliver the goods and perform the services under the contract within the time schedule specified by BNPM in the contract.

Any delay attributable to the supplier in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and performance of services shall render the supplier liable to any or all the following sanctions besides any administrative action such as (a) Imposition of liquidity damages; (b) Termination of contract for default.

10. Extension of Time:

If the contract is delayed in the progress of work by changes ordered in the work, or any clause which BNPM shall decide to justify the delay, then the time of completion shall be extended by a reasonable time.

If at any time during the currency of contract, the supplier encounters conditions hindering timely delivery of the goods and performance of services, the supplier shall promptly inform BNPM in writing about the same and its likely duration and make a request to BNPM for extension of the delivery schedule accordingly. On receiving the supplier's communication, BNPM shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the delivery schedule, with or without liquidated damages for completion of supplier's contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.



11. Risk Purchase Clause:

If the supplier fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the contract/agreement, or fails to supply the material as per the delivery schedule or any time repudiates the contract,

Procure the tendered item / render service from other agencies at the risk and cost of the supplier. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value wherein default has been made will be recovered from the supplier along with the other incidental charges.

In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the supplier.

12. Preference for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE):

Public procurement policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) order, 2012 as notified by Govt of India (GOI) along with its amendments as available in www.msme.gov.in shall be applicable to this tender.

*MSEs should have valid Udyam Registration Certificate to be eligible for consideration under preference for Micro and Small Enterprises (*MSEs).

13. Termination for Convenience (Foreclosure) Clause:

BNPM reserves the right to terminate the contract, in whole or in part for its (BNPM's) convenience, by serving written notice on the supplier at any time during the currency of the contract. The notice shall specify that the termination is for the convenience of BNPM. The notice shall also indicate inter-alia, the extent to which the supplier's performance under the contract is terminated, and the date with effect from which such termination will become effective.

14. Force Majeure: In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the supply of stores arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Contractor shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by BNPM in writing, the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. If the force majeure condition(s) mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.

15. Fore-Closure Clause: If at any time during the continuation of this contract, the use of material ordered in this contract is completely banned or due to drastic change in Government policy its use as, raw material is discontinued or is declared hazardous to public health or cause rising to civil commotion, epidemics, wide-spread strikes and 21 days' notice of such eventualities is given by purchaser to the seller, the seller without any right to enforce the contract, will agree to the fore-close the performance of balance portion of this contract and in that event no claim for damages or loss will be lodged against the purchaser.

16. Settlement of Disputes through Arbitration:

All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after their completion except accepted matters shall be settled through arbitration process as per the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Mysore, Karnataka.

17. Legal Jurisdiction: The Courts of Mysore (Karnataka State) shall alone have jurisdiction to decide on any legal matter of dispute whatsoever arising out or in respect of the contract.

18. Rights of Rejection: BNPMIPL reserves the right to reject any or all the applied bids without assigning any reason whatsoever. The enquiry can be rejected on national security grounds.
