SECTION II - TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. **Price:** The rates quoted will be treated inclusive of all charges and no further claims whatsoever will not be entertained in this respect. The quoted rates should be F.O.R BNPM, Mysuru site basis.
- 2. **Payment terms**: 100% amount of the invoiced value shall be released within 30 days on receipt and acceptance of goods by the consignee at destination (i.e. BNPM, Mysuru) and on production of all required documents by the supplier.
- 3. **Delivery Schedule**: The materials should be supplied within maximum period 10 days from the date of Purchase Order. Time is the essence of this contract. No delay in delivery shall be acceptable and entertained.
- 4. **Delivery Terms:** It is responsibility of the supplier to arrange packing & forwarding, transportation, transit insurance and supply the material on F.O.R BNPM, Mysuru basis only.
- 5. **Liquidated Damages:** In case your quotation is accepted and order is placed on you, the supply against the order should be made within the period stipulated in the order. BNPMIPL reserves the right to recover any loss sustained due to delayed delivery by way of penalty. Failure to supply the material within the stipulated period shall entitle BNPM to impose liquidated damages without assigning any reasons @ 0.5% (Half Percent) of the total value of the item covered in order as LD per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% (Ten Percent) which you unconditionally and expressly agree to unless extension is obtained from BNPM without imposition of LD, without price escalation along with any other denial conditions (if applicable) on valid ground before expiry of delivery period.
- 6. BNPMIPL reserves the right to increase/decrease the quantity specified in this tender enquiry by **±25%** at the time of placement of order at the quoted price.
- 7. The prices quoted should be firm till the supplies are completed. Price quoted should be net and valid for a minimum period of three months from the date of opening of the quotation including corrigenda (if any issued).

8. Evaluation Criteria:

- (i) The technical bids & financial bids shall be opened at one instance and these bids shall be scrutinized and evaluated by the competent committee/ authority with reference to the parameters prescribed in the tender document. Tender will be opened as per date and time mentioned to enable the tenderers to attend the bid opening, if they so desire.
- (ii) **Method of Evaluation:** Evaluation shall be carried out on **Over all Effective Price** quoted by the bidders, unless any other method of evaluation is specifically provided in the enquiry and contract shall be awarded to **Overall Effective lowest (L-1) bidder**. The quoted price should be inclusive of P&F, Freight, Transit Insurance and any other charges required for delivery of item to BNPM, Mysuru on F.O.R basis.
- (iii) **Price Tie:** In case of a price tie at L-1 price for any schedule, company incorporated earlier among the tied parties shall be awarded order. In case of unavailability of incorporation certificates, such as proprietorship & partnership firms, date of GST registration & execution of partnership agreement respectively shall be taken as date of incorporation.
- (iv) All responsive tenderers shall be evaluated as per the terms & conditions of the tender. The basis for arriving at the lowest responsive bidder shall be as per the price quoted for landed cost at Mysuru including GST, packing & forwarding charges, freight, insurance and any other charges etc. and input credit shall be deducted to arrive at the effective price. Effective price shall be considered for arriving the lowest responsive bidder.

- (v) Bidder has to mention appropriate HSN code and quote GST rate provided in Price Schedule. In case of any mismatch in HSN code with respect to offered product, same shall be decided in consultation with winning bidder
- (vi) All tenderers should be registered under GST. They should be eligible to pass on input credit. Bid will be evaluated all-inclusive though input credit will be deducted to arrive at the effective cost.

*If the tenderer is unregistered, the GST shall be payable by the purchaser under reverse charge and shall be added to the quoted rate to arrive at the Gross price and input credit, if any shall be deducted from the total landed cost to arrive at the net comparable price. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.

- 9. Payment of GST is primarily the responsibility of the seller and will not be paid unless the percentage value is clearly mentioned in the quotations. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.
- 10. Delay in supplier's performance: Time for and the date specified in the contract or as extended for the delivery of the stores shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the supplier shall deliver the goods and perform the services under the contract within the time schedule specified by BNPM in the contract.
 - Any delay attributable to the supplier in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and performance of services shall render the supplier liable to any or all the following sanctions besides any administrative action such as imposition of liquidity damages.
- 11. **Extension of Time:** If the contract is delayed in the progress of work by changes ordered in the work, or any clause which BNPM shall decide to justify the delay, then the time of completion shall be extended by a reasonable time.
 - If at any time during the currency of contract, the supplier encounters conditions hindering timely delivery of the goods and performance of services, the supplier shall promptly inform BNPM in writing about the same and its likely duration and make a request to BNPM for extension of the delivery schedule accordingly. On receiving the supplier's communication, BNPM shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the delivery schedule, with or without liquidated damages for completion of supplier's contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.
- 12. **Risk Purchase Clause:** If the supplier fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement arising out of this enquiry (or) fails to supply the material/service as per the delivery schedule or any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser will have the right to,
 - a) Procure the tender item/render service from other agencies at the risk and cost of the supplier. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value where the default has been made, will be recovered from the supplier along with the other incidental charges.

- b) In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the supplier.
- 13. **Force Majeure:** In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the supply of stores arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Contractor shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by BNPM in writing, the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. If the force majeure condition(s) mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.
- 14. Counter conditions (if any on technical & commercial terms) shall be reviewed by BNPM and acceptance of the same shall be at sole discretion of BNPM.
- 15. The BNPMIPL reserves the right to accept the offer by individual items and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof and does not bind itself to accept lowest quotations.
- 16. **Divisibility & split-ability of contract:** Quantity in this tender is not divisible/not split-able.
- 17. **Settlement of Disputes through Arbitration:** All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after their completion except accepted matters shall be settled through arbitration process as per the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Mysuru, Karnataka.
