- The tenderer shall satisfy BNPMIPL that they are competent and authorized to submit tender and/or to enter into a legally binding contract with the BNPMIPL. To this effect, any person giving a tender shall render documentary evidence that his signature on the tender submitted by him is legally binding upon himself, his firm or company as the case may be.

- b) Payment will be made only if the supplied consignment meets the specifications & quality criteria mentioned in the Technical Specifications.

4. Delivery Terms & Delivery Address:

5. Delivery Period: Successful bidder shall complete supply of material within a maximum period of **8 weeks** from the date of placement of Purchase Order.

6. Taxes: All Taxes shall be as applicable in GST regime. TDS, TCS will be deducted as applicable under Income tax act and GST act. Payment of GST is primarily the responsibility of the seller and will not be paid unless the percentage value is clearly mentioned in the quotation.

7. Warranty: NA

8. Liquidated Damages (LD): In case your quotation is accepted and order is placed on you, the work against the order should be completed within the period stipulated in the order. BNPMIPL reserves the right to recover any loss sustained due to delayed delivery by way of liquidated damages. Failure to complete the work within the stipulated period shall entitle BNPM to impose liquidated damages without assigning any reasons @ 0.5% (Half Percent) of the delivered price of the delayed work for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery subject to a maximum deduction of 5% (Five Percent) of the

total contract value which you unconditionally and expressly agree to unless extension is obtained from BNPM without imposition of LD, without price escalation along with any other denial conditions (if applicable) on valid ground before expiry of delivery period. In case of inordinate delay (Inexcusable delays of more than one-fourth (25%) of the total completion period shall be treated as inordinate delays) this maximum deduction shall be 10% of the total contract value.

- 9. Delay in successful bidder's/ Supplier performance:** Time for and the date specified in the contract or as extended for the delivery of the stores shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the successful bidder shall deliver the goods and perform the services under the contract within the time schedule specified by BNPM in the contract.

Any delay attributable to the successful bidder in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and/or performance of services shall render the successful bidder liable to any or all the following sanctions besides any administrative action such as (a) Imposition of liquidity damages; (b) Termination of contract for default.

- 10. Extension of Time:** If the contract is delayed in the progress of work by changes ordered in the work, or any clause which BNPM shall decide to justify the delay, then the time of completion shall be extended by a reasonable time.

If at any time during the currency of contract, the successful bidder encounters conditions hindering timely delivery of the goods and performance of services, the successful bidder shall promptly inform BNPM in writing about the same and its likely duration and make a request to BNPM for extension of the delivery schedule accordingly. On receiving the successful bidder's communication, BNPM shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the delivery schedule, with or without liquidated damages for completion of successful bidder's contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.

- 11. Rejection Replacement:** Materials not meeting our specification will be rejected outright and the rejected material shall be taken back at the cost and risk of the supplier and replacement should be made within mutually agreed timeline from the date of intimation. No payment shall be made for rejected item. If the material is not taken back within the stipulate period, BNPM reserves the right to dispose-off the material at the risk and expense of the successful bidder.

- 12. Risk Purchase Clause:** If the successful bidder fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the contract/agreement, or fails to supply the material as per the delivery schedule or any time repudiates the contract,

- a) Procure the tendered item / render service from other agencies at the risk and cost of the successful bidder. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value wherein default has been made will be recovered from the successful bidder along with the other incidental charges.

b) In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the successful bidder.

13.Termination for Convenience: BNPM reserves the right to terminate the contract, in whole or in part for its (BNPM's) convenience, by serving written notice on the successful bidder at any time during the currency of the contract. The notice shall specify that the termination is for the convenience of BNPM. The notice shall also indicate inter-alia, the extent to which the successful bidder's performance under the contract is terminated, and the date with effect from which such termination will become effective.

14.Settlement of Disputes through Arbitration: All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after their completion excluding the Excepted Matters (detailed below) shall be settled either through Adjudication / Mediation / Arbitration (as per the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996) process as applicable. In case of mediation / arbitration, the venue shall be Mysuru, Karnataka. Excepted matters: Matters for which provision has been made in any clause of the contract shall be deemed as 'excepted matters' (matters not disputable/ arbitrable), and decisions of BNPM, thereon, shall be final and binding on the supplier.

15.Legal Jurisdiction: The Courts of Mysuru (Karnataka State) shall alone have jurisdiction to decide on any legal matter of dispute whatsoever arising out or in respect of the contract.

16.Force Majeure: In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the supply of stores arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Contractor shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by BNPM in writing, the successful bidder shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. If the force majeure condition(s) mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.

17.Fore-Closure Clause: If at any time during the continuation of this contract, the use of material ordered in this contract is completely banned or due to drastic change in Government policy its use as, raw material is discontinued or is declared hazardous to public health or cause rising to civil commotion, epidemics, wide-spread strikes and 21 days' notice of such eventualities is given by purchaser to the seller, the seller without

any right to enforce the contract, will agree to the fore-close the performance of balance portion of this contract and in that event no claim for damages or loss will be lodged against the purchaser.

18. Catalogue/drawing (if applicable) for the quoted products have to be provided along with the bid.

19. Evaluation Criteria: Evaluation shall be done on the basis of **overall effective price** quoted by the bidder and the contract shall be awarded to the **overall lowest (L1) bidder**.

Bidder has to mention appropriate HSN code and quote GST rate provided in Price Schedule. In case of any mismatch in HSN code with respect to offered product, same shall be decided in consultation with winning bidder.

All tenderers should be registered under GST. They should be eligible to pass on input credit. Bid will be evaluated all-inclusive though input credit will be deducted to arrive at the effective cost.

*If a tenderer is unregistered, the GST shall be payable by the purchaser under reverse charge and shall be added to the quoted rate to arrive at the Gross price and input credit, if any shall be deducted from the total landed cost to arrive at the net comparable price. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.

20. Tender Validity: **90 (Ninety) days** from the date of opening of the tender

21. Price Discrepancy:

- If, in the price structure quoted by a tenderer, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless BNPM feels that the tenderer has made a mistake in placing the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall prevail over the unit price and the unit price corrected accordingly.
- If there is an error in a total price, which has been worked out through addition and/or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total corrected; and
- If there is a discrepancy between the amount expressed in words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.
- If, as per the judgment of BNPM, there is any such arithmetical discrepancy in a

tender, the same will be suitably conveyed to the tenderer by registered/speed post. If the tenderer does not agree to the observation of BNPM, the tender is liable to be ignored.

- v. **Price Tie:** In case of a price tie at L-1 price for two or more bidders, after application of purchase preference (against claim of purchase preference by bidder in techno commercial bid with applicable NIC) if it is observed that one of the L1 bidder is MSE, then an order shall be placed on such MSE bidder. In all other scenarios, the order shall be placed on the L1 bidder having a higher turnover in the previous financial year. In case there is a tie at the lowest bid (L-1) position between only startup bidders and none of them has past turnover, the order will be placed on the startup that was registered earlier with the department of industrial promotion and policy.
