MSME's having major activity as **“Trading”** for availing benefits of Priority Sector Lending (PSL) only as per UDYAM certificate are excluded from claiming EMD exemption. Such bidders are required to submit EMD as per tender, else their bid will be considered ineligible/unresponsive and will be ignored.

6. The tenderer shall satisfy BNPMIPL that they are competent and authorized to submit tender and/or to enter into a legally binding contract with the BNPMIPL. To this effect, any person giving a tender shall render documentary evidence that his signature on the tender submitted by him is legally binding upon himself, his firm or company as the case may be.

SECTION II – TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

1. Tenders are to be uploaded on e-tendering portal www.tenderwizard.com/BNP only in Two part bid system.
2. i) **Part-I – Prequalification Bid & Techno-commercial Bid:** Scanned copy of Technical offer (catalogue/brochure etc.), Certificate of Incorporation/Partnership Deed (as applicable), GST, PAN, Bank details etc., along with all sections & annexures of this tender.

ii) **Part II – Price Bid:**
Price shall be furnished through e-portal only. Price offer submitted in any other format will be liable for rejection.
3. **Price:** Price should be inclusive of P&F, Freight, Transit Insurance, TA, DA, and Fooding, Lodging and GST and any other charges as required to complete the entire work. Price shall remain fixed & firm and no price variation shall be accepted till completion of contract.
4. **Payment terms:**
100% Payment shall be made within 30 days after completion of the work and submission of reports and acceptance of the same at Bank Note Paper Mill India Pvt Ltd., Mysore. The payment shall be made after making any statutory deductions at source as per rules, if any.
Payment shall be done in INR only
5. **Contract Period & Completion schedule:**
 - i) Contract period will be for 1 (one) year from the date of issuance of order. Contract period is extendable for another 2 (two) years on yearly renewable basis against satisfactory performance of the successful bidder with same price, terms & conditions & scope.
 - ii) Successful bidder will complete the work within mutually agreed schedule between BNPM & successful bidder for all years.
6. **Address for providing service:** Work is to be performed at Bank Note Paper Mill India Pvt. Ltd., Note Mudran Nagar, Mysore - 570003.
7. **Liquidated Damages:** Environmental Monitoring services shall be completed by the service provider within the mutually agreed schedule between BNPM & service provider. In case of any delay attributable to service provider, a sum equivalent to the 0.5% of the item price of the delayed service for each week of delay or part thereof until actual completion or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed service's contract price. LD shall be applicable against the mutually agreed schedule for all the years.
8. **Warranty:** Not Applicable
9. **Performance Security:-** Performance security has to be submitted by the successful bidder within 21 days from the date of issue of work order, whichever is earlier, for **5% of the contract value** valid up to sixty days after the date of completion of contract period and all contractual obligations by the contractor.

The Performance security shall be denominated in Indian Rupees or in the currency of the contract and shall be in one of the following forms:

- a. Account Payee Demand Draft drawn on any commercial bank in India, in favour Bank Note Paper Mill India Private Limited payable at Mysuru.

- b. Paper Bank Guarantee / e-Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled commercial bank in India, in the prescribed format as provided in this document. BG issued by overseas branch of Indian Commercial Bank will not be accepted.
- c. Insurance Surety Bonds.
- d. Fixed Deposit Receipt (lien to BNPM) from a scheduled commercial bank in India.
- e. Direct wire transfer in acceptable form.

In the event of any loss due to supplier's failure to fulfil its obligations in terms of the contract, the amount of the performance security shall be payable to BNPM to compensate BNPM for the same.

10. Evaluation Criteria:

- (i) The technical bids shall be opened in the first instance and these bids shall be scrutinized and evaluated by the competent committee/ authority with reference to the parameters prescribed in the tender document. Subsequently, in the second stage the financial bids of only technically acceptable offers as decided in first stage shall be opened for further scrutiny and evaluation. Intimation regarding opening of financial bids shall be given to acceptable tenderers to enable them to attend the financial bid opening, if they so desire.
- (ii) **Method of Evaluation:** Evaluation shall be carried out on **Overall effective price** quoted by the bidders, unless any other method of evaluation is specifically provided in the enquiry and contract shall be awarded to **overall lowest (L-1) bidder**. The quoted price should be inclusive of P&F, Freight, Transit Insurance and any other charges required for delivery of item to BNPM, Mysuru on F.O.R basis.
- (iii) **Price Tie:** In case of a price tie at L-1 price for any schedule, company incorporated earlier among the tied parties shall be awarded order. In case of unavailability of incorporation certificates, such as proprietorship & partnership firms, date of GST registration & execution of partnership agreement respectively shall be taken as date of incorporation.
- (iv) All responsive tenderers shall be evaluated as per the terms & conditions of the tender. The basis for arriving at the lowest responsive bidder shall be as per the price quoted for landed cost at Mysuru including GST, packing & forwarding charges, freight, insurance and any other charges etc. and input credit shall be deducted to arrive at the effective price. Effective price shall be considered for arriving the lowest responsive bidder.
- (v) Bidder has to mention appropriate HSN code and quote GST rate provided in Price Schedule. In case of any mismatch in HSN code with respect to offered product, same shall be decided in consultation with winning bidder
- (vi) All tenderers should be registered under GST. They should be eligible to pass on input credit. Bid will be evaluated all-inclusive though input credit will be deducted to arrive at the effective cost.

*If the tenderer is unregistered, the GST shall be payable by the purchaser under reverse charge and shall be added to the quoted rate to arrive at the Gross price and input credit, if

any shall be deducted from the total landed cost to arrive at the net comparable price. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.

11. Payment of GST is primarily the responsibility of the seller and will not be paid unless the percentage value is clearly mentioned in the quotations. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.

12. **Delay in successful bidder's performance:** Time for and the date specified in the contract or as extended for the performance of the services shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the successful bidder shall deliver the goods and perform the services under the contract within the time schedule specified by BNPM in the contract.

Any delay attributable to the successful bidder in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and performance of services shall render the successful bidder liable to any or all the following sanctions besides any administrative action such as (a) Imposition of liquidity damages; (b) Termination of contract for default (C) Forfeiture of performance security.

13. **Extension of Time:** If the contract is delayed in the progress of work by changes ordered in the work, or any clause which BNPM shall decide to justify the delay, then the time of completion shall be extended by a reasonable time.

If at any time during the currency of contract, the supplier encounters conditions hindering timely performance of services, the successful bidder shall promptly inform BNPM in writing about the same and its likely duration and make a request to BNPM for extension of the completion period accordingly. On receiving the supplier's communication, BNPM shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the completion period, with or without liquidated damages for completion of successful bidders contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.

14. **Risk Purchase Clause:** If the successful bidders fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement arising out of this enquiry (or) fails to provide service as per the completion schedule or any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser will have the right to,

- a) Render service from other agencies at the risk and cost of the successful bidder. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value where the default has been made, will be recovered from the supplier along with the other incidental charges.
- b) In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the supplier.

15. **Force Majeure:** In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the supply of stores arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Contractor shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by BNPM in writing, the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. If the force majeure condition(s)



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mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.

16. **Fore-Closure Clause:** If at any time during the continuation of this contract, the use of material ordered in this contract is completely banned or due to drastic change in Government policy its use as, raw material is discontinued or is declared hazardous to public health or cause rising to civil commotion, epidemics, wide-spread strikes and 21 days' notice of such eventualities is given by purchaser to the seller, the seller without any right to enforce the contract, will agree to the fore-close the performance of balance portion of this contract and in that event no claim for damages or loss will be lodged against the purchaser.
17. **Obligations by bidders:**
- i) All bidders are obliged under the CIPP (Code of integrity of public procurement) to suo moto proactively declare any conflict of interest (coming under the definition as mentioned in conflict of interest clause below, pre-existing or as and as soon as these arise at any stage) in any procurement process or execution of contract. Failure to do so would amount to violation of this Code of Integrity; and
 - ii) Any bidder must declare, whether asked or not in a bid document, any previous transgressions of such a Code of Integrity with any entity in any country during the last 1 (One) year of being debarred by any other Procuring Entity. Failure to do so would amount to violation of this code of integrity.
18. **Conflict of Interest:** A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practice to the detriment of BNPM interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified after giving a reasonable opportunity of being heard. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
- a. If its personnel have a close personal, financial, or business relationship with any personnel of the procuring entity who are directly or indirectly related to the procurement or execution process of the contract, which can affect the decision of the procuring entity directly or indirectly;
 - b. The bidder (or his allied firm as defined by DOE, MOF,GOI) provided services for the need assessment/procurement planning of the Tender process in which it is participating;
 - c. A Principal can authorize only one agent, and an agent should not represent or quote on behalf of more than one Principal. However, this shall not debar more than one Authorized distributor (with/ or without the OEM) from quoting equipment manufactured by an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) in procurements under Proprietary Article Certificate or
 - d. A bidder participates in more than one bid in this tender process. Participation in any capacity by a Bidder (including the participation of a Bidder as a partner/ JV member or sub-contractor in another bid or vice-versa) in more than one bid shall result in the disqualification of all bids in which he is a party. However, this does not limit the participation of an entity as a sub-contractor in more than one bid if he is not bidding independently in his own name or as a member of a JV.

19. Counter conditions (if any on technical & commercial terms) shall be reviewed by BNPM and acceptance of the same shall be at sole discretion of BNPM.
20. Bidders are advised to write the page number on each page of the Technical Bid documents submitted.
21. The BNPMIPL reserves the right to accept the offer by individual items and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof and does not bind itself to accept lowest quotations.
22. **Divisibility & split-ability of contract: Quantity in this tender is not divisible/split-able.**
23. **Termination for Convenience Clause:** BNPM reserves the right to terminate the contract, in whole or in part for its (BNPM's) convenience, by serving written notice on the successful bidder at any time during the currency of the contract. The notice shall specify that the termination is for the convenience of BNPM. The notice shall also indicate inter-alia, the extent to which the successful bidder's performance under the contract is terminated, and the date with effect from which such termination will become effective.
24. **Settlement of Disputes through Arbitration:** All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after their completion except accepted matters shall be settled through arbitration process as per the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Mysuru,
25. **Tax deduction at source:** All statutory deduction as applicable shall be deducted at source as per rules at prevailing rates, unless certificate, if any, for deduction at lesser rate or nil deduction is submitted by the Successful bidder from appropriate authority. The successful bidder shall provide accurate particulars of PAN number as required, under Section 206AA of Income Tax Act 1961. TDS as applicable under Income tax & GST act will be applicable.
26. **Tax Collection at source:** Finance Act, 2020 also inserted sub-section (1H) in section 206C of the Act which mandates that with effect from 1st day of October, 2020 a seller receiving an amount as consideration for sale of any goods of the value or aggregate of such value exceeding Fifty Lakh Rupees in any previous year to collect tax from the buyer a sum equal to 0.1 per cent (subject to the provisions of proposed sub-section (10A) of the section 206C of the Act) of the sale consideration exceeding Fifty Lakh Rupees as income-tax. The collection is required to be made at the time of receipt of amount of sales consideration. TCS as applicable under Income tax & GST act will be applicable.
27. **Compensation for damages:**
In case any damage is caused to BNPMIPL due to negligence, carelessness or inefficiency of staff of the agency, the agency shall be responsible to make good the loss. BNPMIPL shall have the right to adjust the damage / loss suffered by it from the security deposit or / and to charge penalty as decided by BNPMIPL. Decision of BNPMIPL in this respect shall be final and binding on the agency. The successful bidder shall keep the Purchaser indemnified from any claims whatsoever inclusive of damages/costs or otherwise arising from injuries or alleged injuries to or death, mishap, injury of a person employed by the successful bidder or damages or alleged damages to the property.
28. **Employment liability towards workers employed by the successful bidder:**



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The successful bidder shall be solely and exclusively responsible for engaging or employing persons for the execution of work. All persons engaged by the successful bidder shall be on successful bidder's payroll and paid by successful bidder. All disputes or differences between the successful bidder and his/her/their employees shall be settled by successful bidder.

29. Safety & Security Measures:

The successful bidder should scrupulously conform to the safety and security norms as stipulated by BNPM while working in the security area. The successful bidder shall take all the precaution while executing this work. Protective gears such as Helmets, shoes, belts, gloves etc. (as required) shall be provided by the successful bidder at his own cost to all his workers at site.

30. **Legal Jurisdiction:** The Courts of Mysuru (Karnataka State) shall alone have jurisdiction to decide on any legal matter of dispute whatsoever arising out or in respect of the contract.

31. **Rights of Rejection:** BNPMIPL reserves the right to reject any or all the applied bids without assigning any reason whatsoever. The enquiry can be rejected on national security grounds.

32. **Preference for Micro and Small Enterprises (*MSEs):** Public procurement policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) order, 2012 as notified by Govt of India (GOI) along with its amendments as available in www.msme.gov.in shall be applicable to this tender.

- a. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) should have valid UDYAM Registration Certificate to avail purchase preference under preference for Micro and Small Enterprises (*MSEs).
- b. MSMEs having major activity as "Trading" for availing benefits of Priority Sector Lending (PSL) only are excluded from the purview of the policy. Any other benefits, including provisions of delayed payments as per MSMED ACT 2006 are excluded.

ETP Gardening water Sample shall be collected from Effluent Treatment Plant Potable water shall collected by Water treatment Plant and Bore well water sample shall be collected.
